The Fifth Sunday after Pentecost

July 10, 2022

This Sunday could well be called the Sunday of Fraternal Charity, a virtue so necessary to observe proper relations with our neighbor. With our weakness and frailty, we cannot preserve peace if we have no compassion for the faults of others, if we do not know how to be kind to those who displease us, and if we cannot bear blame with humility.

INTROIT *Psalm 26:7-9*

Hear, O Lord, my voice with which I have cried to Thee: be Thou my helper, forsake me not, do not Thou despise me, O God, my Savior. *Ps. ibid. 1.* The Lord is my light and my salvation, whom shall I fear? *V.* Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.—Hear, O Lord...

COLLECT

O God, who hast prepared for them that love Thee such good things as pass understanding: pour into our hearts such love toward Thee, that we, loving Thee in all things and above all things, may obtain Thy promises which exceed all that we can desire. EPISTLE *From the First Letter of Blessed Peter the Apostle, 3:8-15*

Dearly beloved: be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, being lovers of the brotherhood, merciful, modest, humble; not rendering evil for evil, nor railing for railing, but contrariwise, blessing: for unto this are you called, that you may inherit a blessing. For he that will love life and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile. Let him decline from evil and do good; let him seek after peace, and pursue it: because the eyes of the Lord are upon the just, and his ears unto their prayers, but the countenance of the Lord against them that do evil things. And who is he that can hurt you, if you be zealous of good? But if also you suffer anything for justice' sake, blessed are ye. And be not afraid of their fear, and be not troubled; but sanctify the Lord Christ in your hearts.

judgment. But I say to you, that whosoever is angry with his brother, shall be in danger of the judgment; and whosoever shall say to his brother: Raca, shall be in danger of the council; and whosoever shall say: Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire. If therefore thou offer thy gift at the altar, and there thou remember that thy brother hath anything against thee, leave there thy offering before the altar, and go first to be reconciled to thy brother; and then coming thou shalt offer thy gift.
