

THE NINTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST July 21, 2024

God knows our weaknesses, the struggles we have to undergo, and the temptations that assail us; and for each of them He gives us the measure of grace we need in order to triumph over them. It is very true that when the storm is raging we can feel only the impact of the struggle and the grace that God is giving to help us remains completely hidden; nevertheless, this grace is there and we should be certain of it, because "God is faithful." "God has always helped me. . . ." St. Therese of the Child Jesus said, "I count on His aid. My suffering may reach even greater heights, but I am sure He will not abandon me."
