

# The Seventh Sunday after Pentecost

## July 24, 2022

*Every Christian may consider himself a tree in the Lord's vineyard; the divine gardener, Jesus Himself, has planted it in good, fertile, productive ground in the garden of the Church, where it is watered by the living water of grace. He has given it the most tender care, cut off its useless branches by means of trials, cured its diseases by His Passion and death, and watered its roots with His precious Blood. He has taken such good care of it that He can say: "What is there that I ought to do more to My vineyard, that I have not done to it?" After all this solicitude, one day Jesus comes to see what kind of fruit this tree is bearing, and by its fruit, He judges it, for a good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can an evil tree bring forth good fruit.*
