THE FIFTH SUNDAY AFTER EASTER May 25, 2025

The first prerequisite for prayer made in the Name of Jesus is humility, which entails a profound and realistic recognition of our insignificance. This should be complemented by the second condition, which is an unwavering confidence in the merits of Jesus, that exceed all our poverty, misery, needs, and necessities. Given Jesus' infinite merits, there is no limit to what we can request in His Name; we can be bold in imploring the fullness of divine grace for our soul and in aspiring to genuine sanctity, even if it remains hidden. There is no fault, lack of fidelity, or evil tendency, nor any sin which, if sincerely repented, cannot be cleansed, purified, and pardoned by the Blood of Jesus. Furthermore, there is no weakness that He cannot heal, strengthen, and transform. Additionally, any individual of good will, regardless of how weak and insignificant, can aspire to sanctity in the Name of Jesus.

Declare it with the voice of joy, and make this to be heard, alleluia: speak it out even to the ends of the earth: The Lord hath delivered His people, alleluia, alleluia. Psalm.
