# RESUMED SIXTH SUNDAY AFTER EPIPHANY NOVEMBER 17, 2024

Perhaps there is but little that we can do for the extension of the Church. Let us, at least, do that little: let us contribute our insignificant labor, as a veritable mustard seed, toward the growth of this wonderful tree, beneath whose shadow all men are called to find salvation and repose.

#### INTROIT Jeremiah: 29:11, 12, 14

The Lord saith: I think thoughts of peace, and not of affliction: you shall call upon Me, and I will hear you; and I will bring back your captivity from all places. *Psalm.* Lord, Thou hast blessed Thy land: Thou hast turned away the captivity of Jacob.  $\tilde{\mathbb{V}}$ . Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.—The Lord saith . . .

#### **EPISTLE I Thessalonians 1: 2-10**

Brethren: We give thanks to God always for you all, making a remembrance of you in our prayers without ceasing, being mindful of the work of your faith and labor and charity, and of the enduring of the hope of our Lord Jesus Christ before God and our Father: knowing, brethren beloved of God, your election: for our Gospel hath not been unto you in word only, but in power also, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much fullness, as you know what manner of men we have been among you for your sakes. 




